Material	Something that an object can be made from.
Bend	To force something that is straight into a curve or an angle.
Squash	To push something together so that is changes shape.
Stretch	To pull something and make it longer.
Twist	To turn something that is still or stand- ing
Push	To move something away from you
Pull	To move something towards you
Elastic	A rubbery material that stretches
Squeeze	To press something firmly together from opposite sides
Dough	A thick sticky mixture of flour and wa-

The shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed.

Some materials can be made smaller by squashing them.

Some materials can be made longer by stretching them.

Some materials can be changed by twisting them.

Some materials can be changed by bending them.

Squashing and bending are push actions.

Stretching and twisting are pulling actions.
