
Biomes of the World



Tier 3 Vocabulary

Biome	A large naturally occurring community of flora and fauna occupying a major habitat.
Climate	The usual weather in a place.
Landscape	A large area of land that you can view from one place.
Animal	Any living creature that can breathe and move about.
Plant	A living organism.
Fauna	The animal life of a particular area.
Flora	The plant life of a particular area.
Climate Zone	A large area with the same type of climate.
