Dalha - If you're good at talking you get a good job.



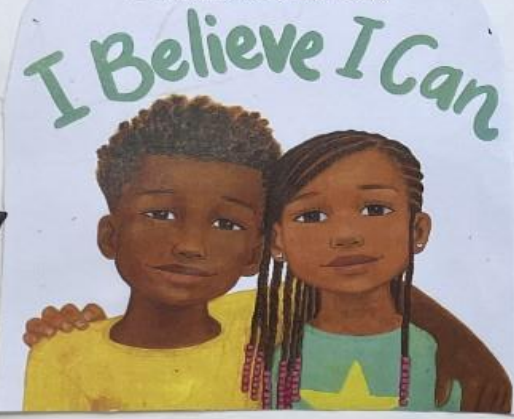

Remembrance Day




Some people might be angry when they remember all the people who lost their lives. (Mikel)








